

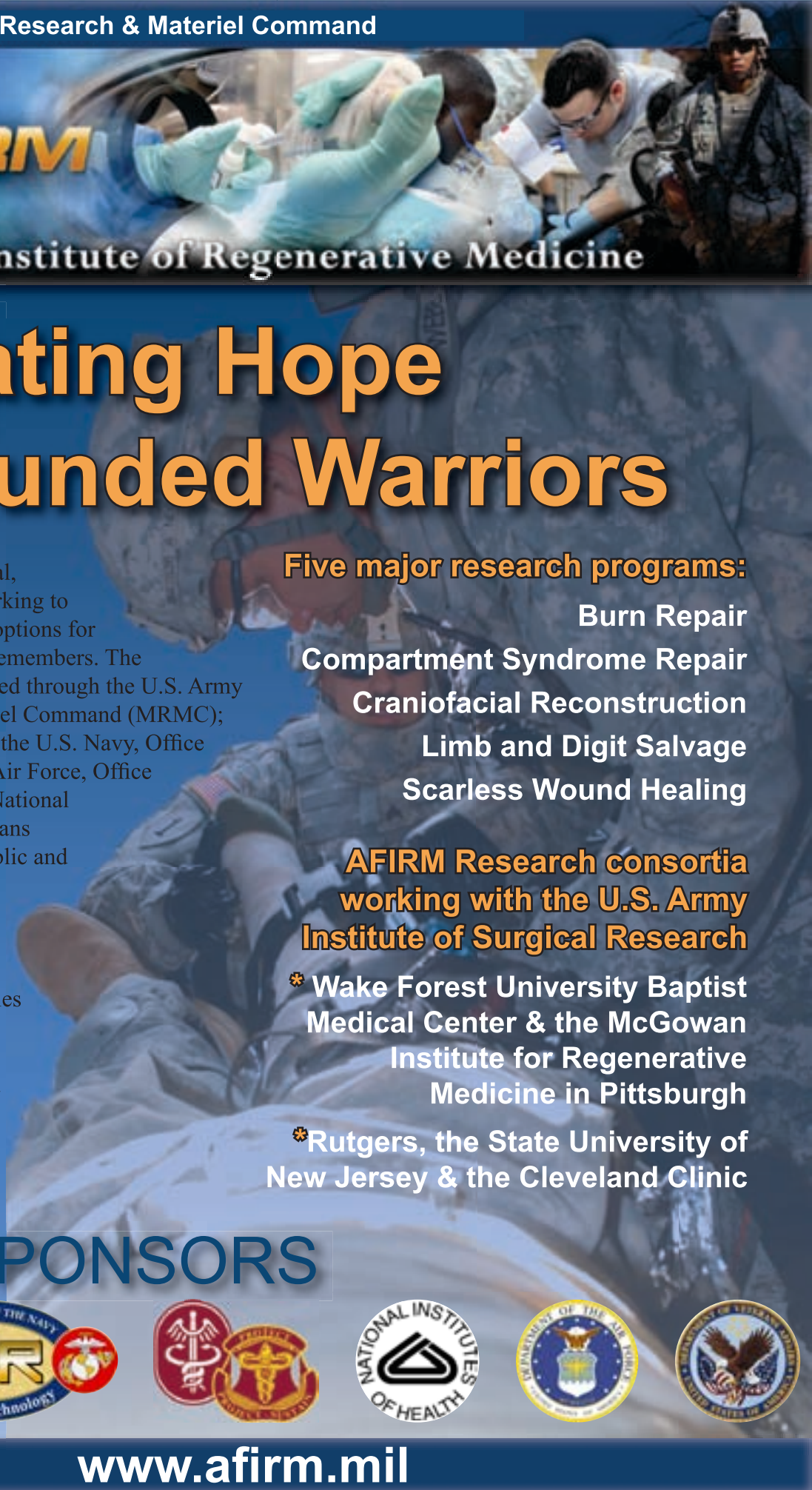

# Generating Hope for Wounded Warriors

AFIRM is a multi-institutional, interdisciplinary network working to develop advanced treatment options for our severely wounded Servicemembers. The AFIRM is managed and funded through the U.S. Army Medical Research and Materiel Command (MRMC); with additional funding from the U.S. Navy, Office of Naval Research; the U.S. Air Force, Office of the Surgeon General; the National Institutes of Health; the Veterans Administration; and local public and private matching funding.

The AFIRM is designed to speed the delivery of regenerative medicine therapies to treat our most severely-injured Servicemembers from around the world, but in particular those coming from our theaters of operation in Iraq and Afghanistan.

- Burn Repair
- Compartment Syndrome Repair
- Craniofacial Reconstruction
- Limb and Digit Salvage
- Scarless Wound Healing
